We need to get back to Acts and into homes!


Therefore, go and make disciples of all the nations...

If we are His disciples, then we too must have compassion.


We Need to Be Givers



Just a couple of verses down in **Matthew 14:16** Jesus instructs his disciples to feed the people.

Whatever is in you to give, **be generous**. Earlier in **Matthew 10:8** Jesus said "freely you have received, freely give."

We Need to Be Selfless



To accomplish the above, we need to empty ourselves of pride and the need to be right.

If we truly care, we'll suffer wrong to bring someone into the knowledge of Christ.

Always consider what's more important to Jesus; to be right or to save a soul?

Opening Discussions

Ask Deep, Probing Questions




Jesus asked the disciples “who do the people say I am?”

When they gave a bunch of answers, he then asked “**who do YOU say that I am?**”

You can only ask and answer such questions when you have a genuine relationship.

Be Bold with The Truth



You shall know the truth and the truth shall set you free.

You first have to believe what you’re preaching.

Belief is seen in our actions and how we live in love, humility and holiness.

Practice Often



Be ready in season and out of season to give the reason(s) for why you believe.

It’s good to know scripture and the common objections, but **don’t get into debates.**

In most cases, people simply need to know what God has done and is doing for you.

Share your testimony.

Your Giving Plan

For each of the names to the left, search your heart and ask God to make a way for you to do something that will **“SHOW”** the person you care.



Here are some ideas and guidelines:

- Ideally, what you do should be directed by God, so spend time praying about it
- It doesn’t have to cost you money, but if it does, don’t look for an earthly reward or thanks – that’s pride and mammon
- A simple phone call, an encouraging word or a hug can do much good
- It shouldn’t be something out of character or something that you can’t maintain
- Be a better listener – ask questions and allow God to direct your interactions
- Don’t set a timeline on God’s redemptive work – relationships take time
- Seize every opportunity to show God’s love and compassion in the earth.



*No one can serve two masters. For you will hate one and love the other; you will be devoted to one and despise the other. You cannot serve both God and money. **Matthew 6:21***

Prayer:

Lord open my eyes to see the needs of others. Lord purify and soften my heart. Make it a heart full of compassion. Pour out your love on me so that I’m overflowing and can give to others without expecting an earthly reward.

Evaluate Your Influence

One of the greatest complaints of unbelievers is people who claim to be followers of God, but do things even they, the unbeliever, wouldn't do.

“...Hypocrites! For you cross land and sea to make one convert, and then you turn that person into twice the child of hell...” Matthew 23:15 (NLT)

Are You A Hypocrite?

- Does the person you want to bring to the Lord see you as compromised?
- Have you been drunk, lost your temper, flirted or told questionable jokes?
- Are you seen as helpful and thoughtful by others? Or lazy, worrisome and judgmental?
- How regularly do you talk with them about personal issues?
- Have you cried together? **Empathy is a good thing.**
- How long have you known them; and they you?
- How long have they known that you're a Christian?
- Have you witnessed to them in the past and “failed”?

You Can Recover

We all make mistakes, but not all of us apologize and ask forgiveness for them. Be different and right the wrongs you've committed. Start in prayer and repentance to God. You'll have more influence.

Understand Readiness



First You

- Do you know how to lead someone to Christ through a “Prayer of Salvation”?
- Are you willing and able to disciple them if they don't want to go to a church service?
- Are you an encourager? Are you forgiving?
- Can you discern spirits and see past a person's sin to their soul for salvation?

Then Them

- Are they looking for real answers or just belly-aching?
- Have you helped them understand that it won't be easy?
- Do they know you will be there to help them, but they must develop a relationship with Jesus for themselves?

Prayer of Salvation Outline

- Admit you are not living according to God's plan
- Be willing to change (repent, give it up, change, move on)
- Believe that Jesus Christ died for you, and rose again
- Invite Jesus into your life to guide you as Lord and Saviour
